The only exceptions are the two documents that come from the university or college: the official grade transcripts and the official letter confirming the applicant's acceptance into the program.</p>

Most recent semester transcripts; followed by Official Grade Transcripts; 4. Two current letters in support of your application from faculty or other professionals who are familiar with your work; 5. A resume or CV; 6. A recent photograph of yourself; 7. A letter of personal introduction to the Jury describing your living connection to your Aboriginal community, how the intended course of study will benefit you in your scholastic pursuit and what the program and your goals mean to
